- CONTESTANTS -

WORLD TAEKWONDO (WT) GLOBAL LICENSE

- A World Taekwondo Global Licence is required by all athletes, coaches and officials participating in Canada Open 2025. World Taekwondo Global License registrations & renewals can only be made through the WT recognized Member National Associations and applications should be made at least 2 months before the tournament starts to ensure the WT Global License can be processed and approved in time. The WT Global License must be valid for 2025 or renewed to be used for 2025.
- The WT Global license is the responsibility of all participants (athletes, coaches and officials) participating at Canada Open 2025 and must be registered and approved through their respective WT Member National Association.
- **There will be NO World Taekwondo Global Licenses registration onsite**

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

- Must have a Kukkiwon Dan or Poom certificate
- Must have a valid 2025 World Taekwondo Global License with event pass
- Must be a member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National Association (MNA), recognized by World Taekwondo
- Age Requirements:
 - Cadet Born in 2011, 2012 or 2013
 - Junior Born in 2008, 2009 or 2010
 - Senior Born in 2008 or earlier

COACH ELIGIBILITY

Must have a valid 2025 World Taekwondo Global License with event pass





















- Must have a World Taekwondo Coach License Level I Coach Certification or the respective CU Coach License (granted by participation in a WT recognized CU Coach Seminar)
 - Any coach that is unable to provide proof of a WT coach certification will not be permitted to coach at this event

Coach Dress Code and Regulations

- Athletic attire/team tracksuit or business attire
- Jeans and doboks are not permitted
- Closed footwear only; no heels or sandals
- No chewing gum or use of electronic devices, such as cell phones, PDA or video cameras
- Coaches perceived to be under the influence of alcohol/drugs will not be allowed in the competition
- All coaches are required to wear a sport coat for the semi-final and final rounds
- Any type of cap/hat is not allowed

KYORUGI COMPETITION

Competition Rules

The latest published World Taekwondo Competition Rules & Interpretation shall be applied

Competition System

- Single elimination tournament system will be used for all divisions of kyorugi competition
- Best of three (3) system

Contest Time

- Cadet and Junior divisions 1:30 minutes each round with 1 minute break between each round
- Senior division 2:00 minutes each round with 1 minute break between each round
- The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as they see fit

Seeding

- Cadet and Junior divisions random draws
- Senior division seeded according to the latest published 2025 World Taekwondo rankings

Draws/Brackets

- Kyorugi brackets will be published one (1) day before the start of each competition day by 4:00pm ET on the following platforms:

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on February 6th, 2025 at the host hotel

Uniform & Equipment

- **PSS:** KPNP Protector and Scoring System
 - Protector and Scoring System (Headgear and Chest Protector) will be provided to athletes
 - The head protector for cadet athletes may be equipped with a face shield
- Uniform: Athletes are required to wear a World Taekwondo recognized kyorugi uniform or Dobok and World Taekwondo recognized protective equipment
- A list of recognized brands can be accessed at worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html
- Athletes are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, KPNP sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use
- Mats: World Taekwondo recognized mats will be used for this event
- Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used

Inspection

- Athletes must pass inspection before each match
- All mandatory equipment is required at the time of inspection
- Athletes will have 10 minutes following their first call on the Inspection Screen to report and pass inspection - NO EXCEPTIONS
- Athletes receiving medical attention are NOT considered checked into inspection

General Weigh-In

- General Weigh-In of athletes shall take place on the day before their respective weight category
 - Athletes may have two attempts to make weight before the end of the weigh-in period
- There will be NO EXEMPTIONS to weigh-in time
- Senior athletes: Weigh-in may be conducted in the nude for senior athletes, if they wish to do so
 - Athletes that are 17 years of age and competing in the Senior division must weigh in with underwear(s)
- Cadet and Junior athletes: must be weighed with clothing, dobok or underwear(s) and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate
- A test scale will be provided one hour prior to General Weigh-in
- Athletes must have photo identification when attending weigh-in
 - Event accreditation can be used as photo identification. Athletes may be asked for additional photo identification (ie. passport, driver's license, school ID, etc.) if event accreditation photo is outdated

Random Weigh-In

- Random weigh-in of athletes shall take place in the morning of the competition day of their respective weight category
 - Random weigh-in will be conducted with plus 5% tolerance of the athlete's weight category
 - Athletes will have one attempt to make the weight
- There will be no random weigh-in for the following individuals:
 - All Cadet divisions
 - Junior heavy weight divisions (M+78kg & F+68kg)
 - Senior heavy weight divisions (M+87kg & F+73kg)





















- The rate of selection for the random weigh-in shall be determined by the number of contestants in the weight category:
 - More than 32 athletes: 20% of total

17-32 athletes: 6 athletes 9-16 athletes: 4 athletes 5-8 athletes: 2 athletes

- 4 or below: no random weigh-in
- Random weigh-in lists will be published at 6:30am ET the morning of each competition day on the following platforms:
 - Website: taekwondo-canada.com/events/canada-open
 - Facebook: facebook.com/Taekwondo.Canada
- Selected athletes must be present at the General Weigh-In area at 8:00am ET
 - Should a contestant that is selected for the random weigh-in fail to appear, he/she will be disqualified

AWARDS

- Individual awards will be presented after the conclusion of each kyorugi competition day
- Team and Special awards will be presented after the conclusion of the Senior kyorugi competition day
- Full results will be posted on the Taekwondo Canada website after each day of competition

Individual Awards

Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in each event

1st Place: Gold Medal 2nd Place: Silver Medal 3rd Place: Bronze Medal 3rd Place: Bronze Medal

Team Awards

- Team awards will be given out to the top three (3) countries based on medalists
- The following point break down will be used to determine the Team Awards:

1st Place: 7 points 2nd Place: 3 points 3rd Place: 1 point 3rd Place: 1 point

Special Awards

- Best Male and Best Female Kyorugi Team Coach
- Best Male and Best Female Kyorugi International Referee
- Best Male and Best Female athlete in the Senior Kyorugi Division

ACCESS TO COMPETITION AREA

- Accreditation is mandatory to access the competition area or the warm-up area.
- By accepting and/or downloading, all accredited persons agree to comply with the Field of Play regulations applicable at Taekwondo events
- Only athletes and their coaches will have admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas

FNTRY VISA INFORMATION

The visa invitation letter for each registered individual will be automatically generated from WT GMS platform if the visa is requested during the registration for the event. All members who need an entry visa to Canada must be registered for the event in GMS. You must then use this letter to apply for you or your team member's visa.

Visa Information

- Participants are required to check Canada's entry visa application waiting times in their own countries and submit requests for recommendation letters through the online form if applicable

 - The visa application process should be started at least one week before the waiting time deadline in the participant's home country

EVENT MEDICAL SUPPORT

Athletic Therapists will be onsite (ringside and in the designated medical area) to provide injury and illness care for all participants

ANTI-DOPING

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions





















- Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes
- The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to this event

Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE)

- TUE Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.
- Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form at International Testing Agency Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) Application Form - International Testing Agency (ita.sport) and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by at least 30 days before the first competition day. MOUTHGUARDS, TAPING & BRACING

The latest published World Taekwondo Mouth guard, Taping and Bracing rules will be applied

MEDICAL INSURANCE

- All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs
