## ELIGIBILITY

### **ATHLETES**

- Must be a member of a team or club of a World Taekwondo Member National Association.
- Must hold valid 2025 Global Athlete License.
- Participants aged 18 and below must provide written consent from a legal parent or guardian when they enter the competition.

### COACHES

- Must be a member of a team or club of a World Taekwondo Member National Association.
- Must hold a valid 2025 Global Official License.
- Must hold a valid World Taekwondo coach level 1 or higher
- Must be aged 18 or above on day of competition.





# COMPETITION RULES

### **COMPETITION RULES**

World Taekwondo competition rules will be used.

### METHOD OF COMPETITION

Single elimination tournament system.

### MATCH TIMES

Senior:	3 x 2-minute rounds, with 1 minute rest between rounds
	3 x 1.5-minute rounds, with 1 minute rest between rounds

### EQUIPMENT

**OVR:** Martial Events

IVR: ReStrike

PSS: Daedo PSS

The Organising Committee will provide KPNP and head protector for all matches. Athletes must provide their own groin guards, mouth guards, gloves, shin and forearms guards and sensor socks.

Mats: TaiShan

Uniform: World Taekwondo recognised brands only.

### PROTEST

Only an official team coach is allowed to protest to the LOC immediately after the end of the contest. The protest fee is  $\pounds 200.00$  and is non-refundable.

### **FIELD OF PLAY RULES**

- Only competitors plus 1 coach will be allowed to enter the field of play for matches, with valid accreditation.
   Failure to display accreditation will result in no admission to the field of play.
- Coaches cannot wear doboks.
- All contestants must attend inspection before entering the field of play for matches. Contestant wearing unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.

### **HEAD OF TEAM / COACHES MEETING**

A Head of Team/Coaches meeting will take place online on Wednesday 19 March before the competition. Attendance is optional.

### **ANTI-DOPING**

Contestants chosen at random may be tested.

#### **DRAW SHEET:**

Draw sheets for each day will be published after weigh-in has finished, usually within 2 hours.

Athletes will be seeded using the most recent World Taekwondo Ranking prior to the event.

#### WEIGH-IN:

To change weight division at the weigh-in will be charged GBP 30.

#### **RANDOM WEIGH-IN:**

Random weigh in for Senior categories: Saturday 22 March 8am

Random weigh in for Junior and Cadet categories: Sunday 23 March 8am

The number of participations selected for random weigh-in will follow World Taekwondo rules. A 5% allowance will apply for every weight division except '+' divisions.
