

Registration fee:

100 € per registered athlete and per category

Payment terms and conditions:

Individual registration payments will not be accepted, payment must be made by team (ONE SINGLE PAYMENT PERTEAM).

Weight changes after the close of registration:

50€ for each weight change.

After the registration deadline, weight changes will be allowed on site as long as they are made before the official weigh-in, and will be paid by credit card.

Additional coach:

50€ for each additional coach. ON SITE PAYMENT

A maximum of one (1) coach for every five (5) athletes will be allowed.

REGULATIONS 2025 CHAMPIONSHIPS

INTERNATIONAL SPANISH OPEN G1

1. ORGANIZATION AND CONTACT

The Organizing Committee will provide the athletes with the <u>DAEDO GEN3</u> helmet, being mandatory for each team to wear the rest of the mandatory protections compatible with this system.

2. COMBATS

A 'best of three' system by direct elimination will be used.

Cadet: 3 rounds of 1 minute and 30 seconds with 1 minute rest. **Junior**: 3 rounds of 1 minute and 30 seconds with 1 minute rest.

Senior: 3 rounds of 2 minutes with 1 minute rest.

The Organization reserves the right to make any modification if necessary.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Each team may enter as many athletes as it wishes per weight category to compete in the Spanish International Open 2025.

- All athletes and officials wishing to register for this event must be in possession of a valid WT Global License.
- In order to participate, teams must belong to a National Association recognized by the European Taekwondo Union (ETU) or World Taekwondo (WT).
- All athletes must prove their age by presenting their passport or identity card at the official weigh-in.

4. TROPHIES, CLASSIFICATIONS AND COMPLAINTS

Medal and diploma for the first, second and third classified. Team classifications: male, female and overall.

Protests must be made according to the competition rules by the official coach within 10 minutes after the end of the bout. The protest fee is 200 € and non-refundable.

The decision on the protest will be announced after 30 minutes (this rule applies in case there is no video replay).

5. COACH

- Minimum age 18 years old.
- Be in possession of a WT Coach Level I Certificate or higher in force.
- Be in possession of a valid WT Global License.
- One (1) coach is allowed for every five (5) athletes. For each additional coach an extra fee will be charged.

6. MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS

Applicable medical regulations:

WT Medical Code, WT mouth guard, braces, bandages, pads and piercings rules are applicable rules, which must be followed by all teams participating in this event.

Applicable anti-doping regulations:

The WT anti-doping regulations and the WADA anti-doping code are applicable. Mandatory random doping tests will be conducted among all athletes. World Taekwondo and/or WADA may conduct random out-of-competition testing prior to the event.

8. IMPORTANT NOTES

To improve the image of the ceremony, the Technical Commission has decided that the presentation of medals to the athletes on the podium will be in Dobok or tracksuit.

The Executive Committee of the WT and the General Assembly of the RFET agreed that in the championships will be sanctioned in accordance with the International Rules of Arbitration the gesticulations, appliance and ostensible gestures of the coaches during the fight, remembering that the sanctions provided can reach the disqualification of the competitor and the coach.

The aforementioned acts incite violence and disorder in the public as well as in the participants, which is against the Royal Decree on violence in sport and the Sports Discipline Regulations, in addition to the deplorable spectacle and so detrimental to Taekwondo given by the violators of these rules.
